In addition to the items listed below, the choice of materials is broad. Wendi invites you to bring watercolors, acrylics, inks, drawing tools, collage materials, and other media that are portable and useful for creating 2D works of art. Supplies may be shared between students as part of the experience. If you need additional materials during the workshop, the Artists Guild in Sturgeon Bay has a wide selection.

Required Materials:

- Sketchbook
- Sketching media, such as graphite, pen, ink, etc.
- Supports of choice to complete up to four pieces, such as stretched canvas, wood panel, or large paper
- Working media of choice. I suggest a variety of drawing, painting, and collage materials to allow for experimentation when applicable. The following is a list of suggested materials. Please feel free to add, subtract, or edit this list.
 - Graphite pencils in varied levels of hardness
 - Charcoal
 - Scissors
 - Extra paper and/or old magazines for collage
 - Acrylic paint
 - Watercolor paint
 - Markers and pens

For ALL classes, remember to bring:

- Sketchbook and pencil for sketching and notetaking
- Comfortable shoes and/or a rubber mat for cement studio floors
- Apron or smock
- Sweater; studios are air conditioned

The items listed above are recommended by the instructor. You may be asked to bring more than you will actually use. The acquisition and cost of these items are your responsibility.
