Your tuition includes shared paints, inks, papers, and more.

Required Materials:

- A roll of paper towels
- Small spray bottle for water
- Sanding block or sandpaper, medium to fine grit
- 3 art panels to work on. They should all be the same size or have one side constant length. For example, 3- 10x10" or 2- 8x10" and 1- 10x10". I would not recommend going any larger than 10x10".
- Scissors
- A couple of paint brushes for glue application
- A jar of matte gel medium, 8 or 16oz should be sufficient
- Apron or work smock
- Pen and sketchbook/notebook
- Cutting set of x-acto knife and blades/straight edge/self-healing cutting mat

Optional Materials:

- Additional papers you may want to collage with
- Dried and pressed plant materials

For ALL classes, remember to bring:

- Sketchbook and pencil for sketching and notetaking
- Comfortable shoes and/or a rubber mat for cement studio floors
- Apron or smock
- Sweater; studios are air conditioned

The items listed above are recommended by the instructor. You may be asked to bring more than you will actually use. The acquisition and cost of these items are your responsibility.
